DRAFT Video-Conference Dependency Hearings (Senator Carol Liu)

2625 (b)

- (1) Judicial Council shall ensure that parents are informed about the dependency court hearings involving their dependent children and right to attend dependency hearings in person or via video-conference in a timely manner in order to facilitate participation.
- (2) A prisoner who is a parent of a child involved in dependency hearing proceedings may elect to participate by video-conference and not be transported to court if the technology is available and this participation otherwise complies with law.
- (3) Under no circumstances shall a prisoner in custody lose internal job placement opportunities, be removed from a court-ordered course, or be denied privileges earned in a correctional institution listed in (a) due to a request to participate or actual participation in these proceedings.
- (4) CDCR is encouraged to seek grants, or whenever possible direct state funds, to purchase teleconferencing equipment as needed in state prisons to facilitate parental participation in court hearings.
- (5) County jails are encouraged to purchase video conference equipment when funding is available.
- (6) Nothing in this section shall be interpreted to replace in-person family visits with telephone calls or video-conferencing. This section applies only to the parent's attendance at dependency hearings.
