



## Free Visiting Shuttle Service

Starting Saturday, April 24, 2010, the City and County of San Francisco, in partnership with the San Francisco Sheriff's Department will start a pilot program providing free Visiting Shuttle Service from the San Francisco Civic Center BART/Muni Station to the San Bruno Jail Complex. This shuttle service will run *only* on Saturdays and Sundays. Please see the shuttle schedule below:

**The shuttle service will operate from 7:15 AM until 3:15 PM:** At 7:15 am, the shuttle will be start from the Civic Center BART/Muni station at 1150 Market Street in San Francisco. The shuttle will leave the station every 90 minutes. The shuttle will drop visitors at the San Bruno Jail Complex front gate. The first shuttle departure from the complex will be at 8:00 AM. The shuttle will then leave every 90 minutes afterward. For questions during hours of service, call the Watch Commander at (650) 266-7501.

**The visiting sign-up schedule will remain the same:** Visitors must still make telephone reservations on Fridays for Saturday visits. Visiting for Sundays will still be on a first-come/first-served sign up at the front gate.

Please be mindful that the visiting shuttle and visiting schedules are different. On Saturdays make sure to take the appropriate shuttle in order to make your scheduled visiting appointment(s). On Sundays, arrive early to sign up for visiting.

**Personal Property:** Due to limited storage space, please limit the amount of personal property brought to the San Bruno Jail Complex.
